

ST MARY'S PAROCHIAL CHURCH COMMITTEE REPORT FOR ANNUAL PARISH MEETING 2021

Due to the pandemic St Mary's Church, Neen Savage, has little to report. The PCC held a meeting in the churchyard during the summer, but the second lockdown put paid to anymore meetings as Zoom facilities were not possible.

The church was closed for the winter obeying diocese regulations but was opened for a very moving service on Christmas Day with prayers, readings and some organ playing.

We have had a quinquennial report with a raft of repairs needed. We have monies in the Fabric fund for some of the minor faults but certainly not for the major ones.

We managed to pay three quarters of the 2020 Parish Share but have not sent anything so far in 2021 as the donations we receive from our loyal supporters have been used to pay for the churchyard mowing, insurance, electricity and church upkeep.

Only two Funerals and a Baptism took place in 2020
