## Summary of activity in 2023-24:

- (1) **Meetings:** the Trustees met in August 2023 to interview applicants for awards; they met again in March 2024 to review the business of the charity and plan fundraising for 2024-25.
- (2) **Grants:** at the August meeting, grants totalling £3,200 were made to 5 young people of the parish, one of them pursuing post-GCSE studies at College, two of them studying for their undergraduate degree at university, and two for Masters qualifications.
- (3) **Charity Commission:** the Foundation's submissions to the Charity Commission are up to date, including the annual accounts. (<a href="www.charitycommission.gov.uk">www.charitycommission.gov.uk</a>, Charity No. 528320).
- (4) **Finances:** income is generated from an investment in the Charities Official Investment Fund (COIF) managed by CCLA; other income is generated from occasional donations and legacies.
- (5) **Fund-raising**: the Trustees are helping to organise the Open Gardens event in the parish on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> June (2-6pm) in conjunction with the Church. Nine gardens are being opened, a prize draw will take place, and tea and refreshments will be available towards the end of the afternoon. Details will be in the June edition of the Vital Link.
- (6) **Beneficiary network**: the Trustees are actively seeking different ways to help young parishioners transition from education to employment, and they are always keen to hear from former beneficiaries who might be in a position to offer their time or expertise in advising or mentoring young people of the parish, offering work experience or internships.
