

Unitary Councillor's Monthly Report for August 2026

I have had a couple of meetings at the Guildhall and the Shirehall this month. The first meeting was regarding a cabinet meeting about the future of the Shirehall. A vote was taken and the result was that the Shirehall is going to be put up for sale. The future of the Shirehall will be in the hands of the new purchaser.

The second meeting was the Full Council meeting. Mostly it was to accept the past financial statements. It was mentioned several times how desperate the Council are financially.

I was due to have a meeting with Andy Keyland the Highways Manager, where I would use the opportunity to chase up outstanding highway issues, but it was cancelled as he is on holiday.

Stottesdon

At the previous parish meeting it was brought up about the bridge near Chorley. I travelled back home via the bridge to see for myself. I can see that the bridge has been repaired, but it has been hit again by a large vehicle or tractor. I have reported it again on Fixmystreet. Also reported several potholes along the way from the bridge to the old Neen Savage school. Be careful because some are quite deep.

Kinlet

I had a meeting with Kiri Pashley, Principal Engineer, regarding the speed limit by the primary school. It was a Teams online meeting. The 20 mph limit is going roughly from the pub to the care home, but they are extending the 30 mph limit further out because to get a 20 mph limit there has to be a certain distance between the two speed limits. It is not going to be 20 mph all the time, but 20 mph when the sign with lights on is flashing during school hours. There was an issue with the bus and children being dropped off on the opposite side of the road. I suggested the bus could go into the village hall carpark and turn around so that the children could get off on the right side of the road safely. They are going to look at putting a path alongside the pub from the junction, but they need to investigate the ownership of the land.
